S. Abrahamson, 90, Dies At Duchess

Svend Abrahamson, 90-year-old native of Norway, died at the home of his daughter and son-in-law, Mr. And Mrs John Hansen, Duchess, on Saturday, October 17 at 11:30 p.m.

The late Mr. Abrahamson was born in Norway on December 10, 1853, and had lived in Canada for twenty-six years. He came from the old country to settle in Kansas, where he farmed, but came to Canada in 1917.
