

AMULUNG - Jeltje Amulung passed away quietly in her sleep on January 23rd, 1999 in Brooks, Alberta. She married Willem Amulung on May 25th, 1939 and together they operated a dairy farm at the edge of Middlestum until coming to Canada in 1953. After brief stops in Caroline and Iron Springs, they moved to Rolling Hills in the spring of 1954 and purchased the home quarter of what is now Amulung & Dewalt Farms. The following years were spent raising her family and making the farm a successful venture. Jeltje's home was always immaculate and in perfect order no matter how trying the conditions may have been. It was a place where flowers always bloomed from every window and friends and family were always welcome and treated to food from her kitchen.
