Surrounded by his family, Timothy "Tim" Arnett passed away peacefully at his brother's home in Edmonton on September 10, 2014 at age 62.

Tim will be deeply missed by his loving wife of 37 years, Gisele; his sons Dustin of Edmonton and Gregory of Saskatoon, SK; his brothers: Dathan (Marian) of Edmonton, Alex (Sheila) of Victoria, B.C. and Jason of Fairview; his sisters: Coralie (Martin) Karabacz of Pincher Creek, Colleen (Tomm) Eberle of Fairview and Tracine (Chris) Belanger of Grande Prairie; as well as numerous nieces and nephews. Tim was predeceased by his father and mother, Clem and Vivien Arnett; his brother Samuel and his sister Salome.

Tim was born in Taber, Alberta where he completed his schooling. He lived in several communities throughout Alberta prior to marrying Gisele. The couple settled in Brooks where he was self-employed and raised their family. Tim retired at age 61 and moved to Tlaxcala, Mexico where he and Gisele taught people about God's Kingdom and enjoyed embracing new friends and a new culture.

Upon returning to Alberta to attend his mother's funeral on June 25, Tim was not feeling well and went to a doctor. He was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia (AML) on July 4.
