

AEBLY - Mrs. Ethel Grace Aebly passed away in Brooks on June 17th, 1995 at the age of 74 years.

Ethel was born at Marwayne, Alberta on March 3rd, 1921. She joined the Canadian Air Force in 1943 and served until her discharge in 1945 for the most part at Pat Bay, Vancouver Island.
