

AIRTH - A pioneer resident of this area and well-known among local farming and ranching circles, Andrew Airth died on November 21, 1972 at his farm residence in the one Tree district, He was 66 years of age.

He was born in Edinburgh, Scotland and came with his parents to the Hutton district at the age of five years where his parents homesteaded, He moved to the one Tree district in 1935 where he has farmed since.
