

ANDERBERG - Mrs. Tilda Anderberg, one of the few very old-timers of the district, passed away at the home of her son, Anton Anderberg at Eyremore, last Saturday morning, November 23. Deceased was seventy-nine years of age.

Mrs Anderberg was born Skone, Sweden, September 6, 1856, and was married in the old country to Mr. Anderberg in 1882. They emigrated to Newfoundland in 1900, later moving to Sydney, Nova Scotia, in 1901. From there they moved to Stockholm, Saskatchewan, and lived there from 1902-09. In that year they took up a homestead at Lomond, Alberta.

Mr. Anderberg pre-deceased his wife in 1922 and since then she had lived with her sons in this district. Left to mourn her loss are three sons, O .P. of Riverbow, A. K. of Eyremore and E. of Hussar, and eighteen grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Monday from the Rainier Community hall, Arrangements were made by L. M. Foote and Rev J. W. Hallett conducted the service. The interior of the hall was very effectively arranged through the kindness of J. R. Jeffrey and others.

Mrs Anderberg had made many friend in the district and her loss will be deeply regretted.
