

Anderson - Edwin Albin Anderson died in the Hanna Hospital on July 24, 1984 at the age of 79 years.

He was born at Balzac, Alberta on July 2, 1905 and came to the Sunnynook area in 1912. He homesteaded west of Sunnynook in the Frazerton district in 1921 and farmed and ranched there until retiring in 1981 due to ill health.

He married the former Lillian Grewer in December 1935.
