

ELLEN ALBERTINA ANDERSON

Ellen Albertina Anderson died on June 5, 1982 in the Brooks Health Centre at the age of 79 years.

She was born in Sweden and came to Canada in 1910 to Bawlf, Alberta. She received her schooling at Eastend Saskatchewan and married at Robsart, Saskatchewan in 1923 farming there with her husband until moving to Rolling Hills in 1951. She farmed at Rolling Hills and Scandia until retiring to Brooks in 1962.

She was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church and the Trinity L.C.W.

She was predeceased by her husband, Elmer on March 15, 1975 and one son, Lowell in February 1963.
