

Mr. James Robert "Bob" Anderson passed away in Brooks on November 9th, 1996 at the age of 74 years.

Born at Boyne Lake, Alberta on October 19th, 1922 Bob was raised and schooled in the Boyne Lake/McRae area where his family ran the local store. He joined the army in 1942 and served in Canada until his discharge in 1945.

He married the former Dortha "Betty" Cherrett on March 30th, 1946 in Calgary and they lived in Ashmont, moving to Brooks in 1947 where Bob went to work for the Postal Service. He remained there until his retirement in 1978. Bob was an active member of the Royal Canadian Legion and had served as president and vice-president.
