

ANDERSON - Robert Murrell Anderson of Brooks, Alberta died on July 17, 1988 in the Victoria General Hospital in Victoria, B.C. at the age of 78 years.

He was born at Granum, Alberta and came with his parents to Wardlow in 1912 where he received most of his education and later took a motor mechanics course at the Calgary Tech.

He was employed as a mechanic for many years at Kelvington, Saskatchewan and B.C. before returning to Alberta to take over his father's ranch.

He semi-retired to Brooks in 1968 and then worked for Delday's Transport for several years.

He was active in the Brooks and District Museum, was a member of the Brooks Masonic Lodge and Helen Chapter No. 91 of the Order of Eastern Star.

He was predeceased by his parents, Dr. and Mrs. W.G. Anderson and a brother Jack.

Surviving are his wife Ina of Brooks, a daughter Jo Lee and her husband Dick Godfrey, two sons, Ross and David and daughter-in-law Judy, eight grandchildren, one great-grandchild, a sister Lee (Mart) Shields of Edmonton and several nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held on Thursday, August 4 at 2 p.m. in Brooks United Church with the Reverend Wes Hutton and the Reverend Garry Lyall officiating.
